

Simple Moss/Seed Stitch Hat

This hat is a simple knit that's great for showcasing those yarns that feel so soft, but don't necessarily have great stitch definition. The moss/seed stitch itself is squooshy, which accentuates the natural softness of any yarn.



Materials

- About 100 yards any worsted weight yarn (example used elsebeth lavold Baby Llama in Dark Brown)
- 16" US size 8 circular needle
- 5 US size 8 dpns (Or size needed to get gauge)
- tapestry needle

Abbreviations

k - knit

p - purl

sts - stitches

k2tog - knit two together

P2tog - purl two together

Gauge

4 stitches per inch in moss/seed stitch

Pattern Instructions

Cast on 88 stitches

Ribbing:

K2, p2 around for 10 rows

Hat body:

Round 1: k2tog, *p1, k1* around

Round 2: *p1, k1* to last st, p1

Round 3: *k1, p1* to last st, k1

Repeat rounds 2 and 3 until hat is between 5 and 6 inches long.

Decreases:

Round 1: *K2tog, p2tog, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, p2tog, k2tog, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1* 4 times, ending with a k1 (71)

Round 2: *p1, k1* to last st, p1

Round 3: *K2tog, p2tog, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, p2tog, k2tog, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1* 4 times, ending with a k1 (55)

Round 4: *p1, k1* to last st, p1

Round 5: *K2tog, p2tog, k1, p1, k1, p2tog, k2tog, p1, k1, p1* 4 times, ending with a k1 (39)

Round 6: *p1, k1* to last st, p1

Round 7: *K2tog, p2tog, k1, p2tog, k2tog, p1* 4 times, ending with a k2tog (23)

Round 8: *p1, k1* to last st, p1

Round 9: k1, *p2tog, k2tog* around (13)

Round 10: *k2tog, p2tog* around (6)

Cut yarn and pull through remaining 6 sts and weave in ends.



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
